On December 9, 1963, Mr. WILLIAM H. SHELLEY, Warehouse Foreman, Texas School Book Depository (TSBD), advised that no time clock or register of any kind is maintained for the warehouse employees of TSBD. The only record maintained is the payroll record that shows whether or not the employee was present on a specific date. Each morning after working hours begin, he checks to see that each employee is present and on the job, and if any employee is missing, he notes this fact and advises Mr. TRULY, who in turn notifies Mr. AIKEN, who keeps the payroll records. The only permanent record maintained is that record maintained by Mr. AIKEN for the payroll.

Mr. SHELLEY stated specifically that on the morning of November 22, 1963, he did not see OSWALD with any package and, in fact, did not actually see OSWALD arrive at work but did see him at about the time the work day commenced, and at that time OSWALD had no package.

Mr. SHELLEY stated there is no way to determine what other employee, or employees, arrived for work at about the same time as OSWALD on that or any other date.
