Mr. ROBERT STOVALL, President, Jaggars-Chiles-Stovall Company, 522 Browder Street, Dallas, Texas, advised his company purchases all rolled Kraft Wrapping Paper from Pollock Paper Company, Dallas, a subsidiary of St. Regis Paper Company.

STOVALL advised, however, that the rolled paper which was being used during March and April, 1963, during time of employment of LEE HARVEY OSWALD with that firm, had long since been used up in the course of business. A sample of 24", 60 lb., Kraft Wrapping Paper was furnished by Mr. STOVALL as an example of the type of Kraft paper used by his firm.

STOVALL advised further his company uses only 1" x 1 1/2" gummed tape in the course of business and has had no 3" gummed tape on the premises in the last several years.
