Lt. J. CARL DAY, Identification Division, Dallas, Texas, Police Department, advised that upon further reflection concerning obtaining of paper samples and tape samples by him from the Texas School Book Depository on the afternoon of November 22, 1963, he now recalls he observed four rolls of Kraft wrapping paper attached to the wrapping table on the main floor of the Depository building. He advised however that he was assisted in gathering evidence at the Depository by Detective ROBERT LEE STUDEBAKER and that STUDEBAKER physically removed the samples at DAY's instruction.

DAY advised he does recall observing STUDEBAKER obtain the one sample of wrapping paper from the roll of paper located on the northeast corner of the wrapping table. He stated further that he recalls observing STUDEBAKER remove one sample of gummed 3" paper tape from the only tape dispenser at the wrapping table. He advised further he turned over the one paper sample and the one tape sample to Bureau Agents for transmittal to the FBI Laboratory.
