Detective JOHN P. ADAMOJK, Dallies Folice Department, advised that he had participated in a search of the PAINE residence, 2515 West 5th Street, Irving, Texas, in November 22 and 23, 1963. He recalled seaing some cameras at the residence but believed they belonged to Mrs. PAINE and believed they had been picked up and brought in to the Dallas Police Station. During the search Mrs. PAINE pointed out what belonged to CSWALD and what belonged to her. He recalled that most of the property in the garage belonged to CSWALD and most of his property was brought in, particularly anything they believed to be of any evidentiary value.

Detective ADAMOIK was shown PHI laboratory photograph D-146 of an Imperial Reflex camera which had been obtained from ROBERT CSWAID, Denton, Texas, on February 24, 1264. He stated that he could not recall ever assing this camera and that he did not recall seeing any cameras during a search of the garage at the PAINE residence. He added, "If we had seen a camera among his belongings we would have certainly brought it in."
