

**O'Donnell Says Manchester
Pledged to Delay Book to '68**

BOSTON, Feb. 13 (AP) — Kenneth P. O'Donnell said today that William Manchester had promised him that none of the information he provided would

be published before the election of 1968.

Mr. O'Donnell said he and other aides of President Kennedy had consented to be interviewed "only on the basis that none of the information would appear" before the next Presidential election.

Mr. Manchester is the author

of "The Death of a President" which has been appearing in condensed form in Look magazine.

Mr. O'Donnell said that Mr. Manchester had "never mentioned magazine serialization to me. This wasn't any contract with Senator Robert F. Kennedy. This was his promise to me."
