Among the deceased he lists Jack Ruby, columnist Dorothy Kilgallon, David Ferrie and Earlene Roberts,

Oswald's landlady.

Miss Kilgallon, according to Jones, had a private conference with Jack Ruby and was onher way to New Orleans to "crack the case
