Article on JFK Picture Disputed

Esquire magazine has issued a release about an article in its December issue stating that "a newly discovered photograph" obtained from United Press International appears to confirm the existence of a second assassin in the slaying of President John F. Kennedy.

The article is based in part

on conclusions drawn by the author from a blowup of the picture which was taken from one frame of a film of the assassination. The article states erroneously that three UPI editors are proponents of a theory that the picture indicated a second slayer.

Various frames of the film are contained in the Warren re-

port. A 1,200-word dispatch, written by UPI staff correspondent Jack V. Fox, was carried last June 27 by the UPI. It discussed the picture in question in detail.

In his dispatch, Fox said that after talking to witnesses, studying the Warren report and various challenges, he was satisfied with the Warren report findings.
