WASHINGTON, April 21 UPI)---The Federal Bureau of ÷. Investigation said today that it was hunting the assassin of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. with "all possible vigor," but that there was 9 a nothing new to report. The manhunt is in its 17th day. The accused assassin, James Earl Ray, has been placed on the bureau's roster of most wanted criminals, and a special alert has been ordered along the Mexican border.

J. Edgar Hoover, the F.B.I. a director, put Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, on the mostwanted list to insure the widest possible dissemination of the 40-year-old escaped convict's picture and description to the police and public
