WASHINGTON, Dec. 25 (UPI) -In what the Rev. Philip F. Berrigan called "our way of celebrating Christmas," 37 protesters performed a medieval morality play in front of the White House today and said a mass that likened President Nixon to King Herod. Six persons were arrested.

Two protesters were arrested for vaulting the black iron fence around the White House and walking toward the mansion where Mr. Nixon was having Christmas dinner with his family. The two demonstrators, Deborah Daniell and Mitchell Snyder, were charged by the Secret Service with unlawful entry.

The two, according to an eyewitness, John McGuirk, "went over the fence and walked directly toward the rotunda. Mitch was grabbed right away and hauled off. Debbie knelt down and was carried off. They were trying to deliver pictures of Vietnamese children who were mutilated because of Nixon's orders.'

Four other protesters who chained themselves to the fence were arrested on charges of disorderly conduct. They were identified as Rosemary Brandle, Teresa Kohlenberg, Gerard Gange and Joan Cavenaugh.
