

Grand DeG Silence On JFK Death Quote ^{10/20/67}

PARIS (AP)—Silence and skepticism were the main reactions today to a French journalist's book reporting that President Charles de Gaulle believes police were involved in the assassination of President Kennedy and the slaying of Lee Harvey Oswald.

De Gaulle's office to comment on the report by Raymond Tournoux that the French president said the assassination:

"The police did the job, or else they pulled the string or else they let it happen. In any case they were involved."

Police Chief Charles Batche-

lor of Dalias said: "We are standing on the reports of the investigation by the Warren Commission and will have no comment on the statements attributed to General De Gaulle."

The White House also refused comment.
