

Teens Desecrate Jack Ruby's Grave

CHICAGO (AP) — A tombstone bearing the name of Jack Ruby was being held at a police station after vandals apparently carried it nearly two miles from the cemetery where Ruby is buried.

Police said the tombstone was found Saturday night by two teenage brothers in a street about two miles from the Westlawn Cemetery on the Northwest Side.

Ruby, under a death sentence for slaying Lee Harvey Oswald, the accused assassin of President Kennedy, died of cancer in a Dallas hospital Jan. 3, 1967.
