- The assassinations commutice, formed in September to investigate the murders of John F. Seenedy and Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., officially went out of business of the first day of the new session last week when a lone member objected to its extension.
- Tomorrow a resolution requiring a two-thirds vote of approval will seek House permission for continued operation of the assassication committee with a budget of approximately \$10,000 a month while the House Administration Committee ponders the long-range financing request.
