Oswald Note To Hunt Proved

DALLAS (UPI) — A Dallas newspaper yesterday said three handwriting experts have examined a controversial letter dated Nov. 8, 1963, and addressed to a "Mr. Hunt" and concluded that the writer was Lee Harvey Oswald.

The terse note asking "Mr. Hunt" for "information concerning my position" was first disclosed Feb. 6 by the Dallas Morning News. The letter was forwarded to the FBI.

Handwriting analysts said the writing compared to that of Oswald contained in the Warren Commission Report.

The note began, "Mr. Hunt. I would like information concerning my position. I am asking only for information. I am suggesting that we discuss the matter fully before any steps are taken by me or anyone else."

It was signed, "Thank You, Lee Harvey Oswald."

Spokesmen for the H. L. Hunt family have denied the accusations.
