Dear Mr. Stone:

The exhibits in the above-entitled case should now be available to you for viewing at the Federal Archives and Records Center in Laguna Niguel, California. I have enclosed a copy of the instructions we have sent to Mr. Kenneth Rossman concerning the Sirhan exhibits.

We are still in the process of identifying and locating the records you requested to view in the district attorneys files. The Sirhan file is quite large and requires one complete storage vault. In addition, as the result of our efforts to rescind the parole release date of Sirhan Sirhan, many of these records have been filed in new or different sections or have been reclassified. This activity compounds the problem of locating and identifying the requested records. Many of the records which you requested were submitted to us by outside law enforcement agencies. These agencies must be contacted and consulted as to the status of their records, i.e. are they still confidential? We soon hope to have an answer for you as to the availability of district attorney records that were not marked as exhibits in the Sirhan court proceedings.
