Dear Mr Welsh,

My mail from California indicates that the April launch has been postponed to June, and that you are presently in Spain. Nevertheless, I am writing in the hope that you will see this letter on your return.

Naturally I am disappointed about the postponement, but that in itself would not occasion a letter. I am in somewhat of a dilemma, frankly, because I have some confidential information which I cannot possibly disclose without violating a categorical promise—and that information suggests that it would be very, very unfortunate to put things off to June. I would like to appeal to you to see if anything can be done to initiate the "forum" in the May issue, since April obviously would be out of the question at this late date.

I realize that I am not giving you any ground whatever to explain or justify such an effort, but I hope that you feel sufficient confidence in me to understand that I should not make such a plea without compelling reasons. I have the impression that you have an article by Fred Cook on hand; also, David Lifton's "Dialogue," which I have read and which has impressed me as basically sound and quite effective.

Please forgive me for being intrusive and mysterious. I wouldn't take such a liberty but for my concern that the RAMPARTS campaign should have maximum impact and strategic timing.
