Thank you for your letter of the 10th and the revised condensation of my views on Garrison. I appreciate your having made the changes I requested and have no objection to publication of the condensation in Forum.

I hope that you will meet with success in your plans to obtain increased resources and public interest, and certainly in your discussions with the members of Congress. Self-evidently, capturing the interest and the commitment of a prestigious senator might in the end be far more effective than most other efforts to arouse public opinion or to influence official policy. Of course, it is a subject on which most politicians will be very reticent to speak or act boldly, and thus incur serious risks of offending the many powerful parties who have a vested interest in maintaining the Warren Report as "history."

I look forward to seeing your article, presumably in the next Forum. Unfortunately, I have no real experience in the production of this kind of newsletter, but I do hope that you will be able to use slightly larger type in later issues.
