Mr. CALVERLEY was shown a photograph of the leather sling used as a rifle sling on the rifle used in the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY, although he was not told the use of this object. *
Mr. CALVERLEY said that he had never seen such an article in OSWALD's possession, and that this article was not any property of Jaggars - Chiles - Stovall, Inc.; however, he believed that this article looked like a camera case strap.
