Mr. BUD MOORE, owner, Bud's Gun Shop, 203 North Eighth Street, Killeen, Texas, advised after being furnished a desc iption of an individual who allegedly had purchased a scope mounted rifle from his store, that he recealled a customer being in his store at approximately 9:00 a.m. on November 15, 1953, who answered the general description as furnished and that this individual was one WALKER BOREN, a rancher who lived in Kempner, Texas, and a regular customer of the gun shop. Mr. MOCRE stated that EOREN was a white male in his middle or late forties, approximately 5'7" to 5'8", 170 pounds, who wore glasses, and generally presented a rough appearance with old outdoor ranch wear.

Mr. MOORE stated that it was his recollection that WALKER BOREN on November 15, 1963, traded a Japanese 6.5 milimeter rifle mounted with a scope for a Springfield M1903 30.06 rifle, Serial Number 3097818. Mr. MOORE stated that BOREN was allowed \$33,95 on the trade-in of his Japanese rifle, Serial Number 19472 against the purchase price of the Springfield M1903 30.06 rifle of \$39.95. MOORE related further that he recalled some conversation with BOREN concerning the scope mounted on a Japanese rifle but no longer recalls specifically what was stated. Mr. MOORE stated that the rifle obtained by BOREN in trade definitely did not contain a scope.
