Jack Ruby's Doctors Say 'No Change'

Jack Ruby continued his fight with cancer Saturday at Parkland Hospital, where no change was reported in his condition.

The most recent report from doctors was that Ruby's condition was "unchanged."

Meanwhile it appeared that Atty. Gen. Waggoner Carr's order for a lie detector test for Ruby would go unanswered.

Doctors and polygraph operators have said that Ruby's physical condition would make such a test impossible.

The slayer of Lee Harvey Oswald, the accused assassin of President Kennedy, entered his third week of treatment after entering the hospital Dec. 9 for tests which later revealed presence of car cer in his chest wall and pancreas.
