Ruby's Condition Said Unchanged

A weakened Jack Ruby passed his 19th day in Parkland Hospital Tuesday with a brief bulletin noting only there was "no essential change" in his condition—officially listed as serious.

The convicted slayer of Lee Harvey Oswald has required small amounts of medication to control nausea, an occasional condition troubling him for several weeks, but as yet has not required any pain-allaying drugs, sources said.

"Other than feeling weak, he is resting comfortably," the bulletin issued through Sheriff Bill Decker's office declared.
