Ruby Sanity Trial Set

DALLAS — A sanity trial for convicted slayer Jack Ruby has been scheduled for June 13 in Dallas. Dist. Court Judge Louis T. Holland also set June 10 as the date for any pre-trial motions. Holland, who replaced Judge Joe B. Brown in the controversial case, took the action after the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals called last week for the sanity hearing "without delay." Ruby was sentenced to death for the Nov. 24, 1963, slaying of Lee Harvey Oswald, the man the Warren Commission identified as the assassin of President Kennedy.
