WASHINGTON (AP) — An
attorney for Jack Ruby has
asked the Supreme Court for a
stay of a sanity hearing

stay of a sanity hearing scheduled June 13 in Dallas, Tex.

Ruby received a death sentence for slaying Lee Harvey Oswald, identified by the War-

ren Commission as the assassin of President John F. Kennedy.
The request filed by William M. Kunstler, New York City attorney, also asked for a stay of all state court appeal proceed-ings pending the filing of an appeal to the Supreme Court from the denial of a writ of habeas corpus for Ruby in Texas.

The State of Texas will have an opportunity to file a reply before the matter is submitted to Justice Hugo O. Black.
