U.S. Supreme Court Denies Ruby Appeal

WASHINGTON, June 4.—(AP)
—Jack Ruby, convicted slayer
of Lee Harvey Oswald, has
lost a bid for a stay in a sanity
hearing set for June 13 in Dal-
las, Tex.

Justice Hugo L. Black of the
Supreme Court denied the re-
quest, saying: "I do not feel
justified in granting a stay
which will interfere with the
orderly and customary proc-
esses of the courts of Texas in
attempts to give Ruby a fair
and prompt determination of his
rights."

Oswald was identified by the
Warren commission as the
assassin of President John F.
Kennedy. Ruby faces a death
sentence.
