**BLACK REFUSES TO STAY  
RUBY'S SANITY HEARING**

WASHINGTON, June 4 (AP).—  
Justice Hugo L. Black of the  
Supreme Court refused yester-

day to stay a sanity hearing for  
Jack Ruby, convicted of killing  
Lee Harvey Oswald, named by  
the Warren Commission as the  
assassin of President John F.  
Kennedy.

Black issued a brief order of  
denial in which he said, "I do  
not feel justified in granting a  
stay which will interfere with  
the orderly and customary pro-

cesses of the courts of Texas  
in attempts to give Ruby a fair  
and prompt determination of his  
rights."

Ruby's lawyer asked that the  
sanity hearing be deferred until  
a formal appeal in the Ruby  
case was filed in the Supreme  
Court. The sanity hearing is  
scheduled for June 13 in Dallas,  
Tex.
