WASHINGTON (AP) — Jack Ruby, convicted slayer of Lee Harvey Oswald, has lost a bid for a stay in a sanity hearing set for June 13 in Dallas, Tex. Justice Hugo L. Black of the

Justice Hugo L. Black of the Supreme Court denied the request saying: "I do not feel justified in granting a stay which will interfere with the orderly and customary processes of the courts of Texas in attempts to give Ruby a fair and prompt determination of his rights.

Oswald was identified by the Warren Commission as the assassin of President John F. Kennedy. Ruby faces a death sentence.
