For nearly two years, a parade of lawyers representing Ruby have insisted the 55-year-old former bar operator was mentally unbalanced in November 1963 when he shot Oswald. sister, Mrs. Eva Grant, in which she said he was insane. The lawyers claim the May 18 ruling was based on the affidavit and its withdrawal would in effect would remove the necessity of a sanity hearing.

The Warren Commission named Oswald as President John F. Kennedy's assassin. They said their reason for the request was a sanity hearing would violate Ruby's constitutional rights.

The Texas Court of Criminal Appeals said May 18 a sanity
