

Friday 7 p.m. Channel 2 news March 19, 1965

Jack Ruby appeared in a Dallas court today and tried to get a change of attorney and removal to federal jurisdiction. Charged a terrible conspiracy by the whole world against him. His lawyers were conspiring with the State to find him insane. Wes Wise spoke to him, and (quote ends here) Ruby's voice was heard for the first time, as he was not a witness at his trial. Film now showed Ruby walking out of a courtroom or building, preceded by an official --possibly Sheriff Decker?--His remarks included the phrases,

"Complete conspiracy...and the assassination too...
if you knew the facts you would be amazed..."

and remarks to the effect that he was perfectly sane, in good health mentally and physically--He asked the reporter if he appeared or spoke like a person who was not sane.

The announcer then said, "But the federal judge remanded the case..." to (?) a State judge, but not Judge Joe Brown.

SM prediction 3/19/65--Look for early death of Jack Ruby by suicide, misadventure, or illness.

Ruby case - judge rejected claim by Civil Liberties Union & Ruby family, remanded to ~~Federal~~ District court.

WOR 8 pm

Ruby swore that LHO on spec of murder, not part of any Communist conspiracy behind it was his destiny to kill JFK's assassin. Case remanded to State court.
