On May 29, 1964, Mrs. FRANCES HAYS, 913 Forest Ridge Drive, Garland, Texas, telephone Broadway 6-0140, telephonically contacted the Dallas Office and advised SA W. HARLAN BROWN that she had been interviewed previously concerning her knowledge of the assassination of President KENNEDY.

Mrs. HAYS stated that a photograph had recently been given to her by Mr. WYMAN PARR, owner of the Glendale Camera Store, 4448 South Marsalis Street, Dallas, Texas, which photograph had been given to him by someone unknown to Mrs. HAYS.

Mrs. HAYS stated she did not know who had taken the photograph and that the photograph in her possession was a copy of one taken near the place where the President was assassinated, showing the old Court House and a close-up of the limousine in which the President was riding. Mrs. HAYS advised that in this photograph is an individual who bears a resemblance to JACK RUBY, the convicted murderer of LEE HARVEY OSWALD. Mrs. HAYS remarked that possibly the FBI already knew where JACK RUBY was at the time of the assassination, but that she would mail such photograph to the Dallas FBI Office for its use in the event such picture had not previously been made available. Mrs. HAYS stated that the photograph is in black and white and that she has no additional information concerning the person who may have taken the pictures.

On June 1, 1964, the above-described photograph was received in the mail at the Dallas Office of the FBI from Mrs. FRANCES HAYS.
