On March 31, 1964, Mr. LEON D. HUBERT, JR., of the President's Commission, telephonically advised SAC J. GORDON SHANKLIN that on that date during the questioning of Lieutenant JACK REVILL, of the Dallas Police Department, it was brought out that an individual identified as Reverend RAY RUSHING, of Plano, Texas, had furnished Lieutenant REVILL sometime during the trial of JACK L. RUBY information that on November 24, 1963, as Reverend RUSHING was going up the elevator at the Dallas Police Department at about 9:30 AM, he believed he saw JACK RUBY on the same elevator. Reverend RUSHING reportedly was endeavoring to see if he could give spiritual guidance to OSWALD.

Mr. HUBERT requested that this allegation be resolved.
