Unfortunately I did not have time to examine CD 1544 but perhaps I will be able to have access to the viewer again tomorrow. It looks as though it might be interesting.

After I receive the Index of Documents, I wonder if I can order what I need directly from Rhoads without having to trouble you, Vince? Is there any way of calculating the price in advance, so as to be able to send a prepaid order?

Jones Harris told me last week that he would be visiting you around now to hear the four-hour tape recording. I would have loved to come too but I am stuck in the Trusteeship Council. Are you writing up the results of your Monday visit to the Archives—frame 292 and the man in the cape? I would love to have a look, if you do write it up.
