Would you send the accompanying copy of the letter to Vincent to Wecht together with any note you may think appropriate. I don't have his address.

Wecht's talk the other night again demolished Latimer's qualifications to read and draw inferences from the restricted autopsy X-rays and photographs. He also said several surprising things. For example, the stock of the Mannlicher-Carcano rifle was "split." I didn't know that. When did that become known? And under what circumstances. He also seemed to say that Oswald had ordered the rifle, and, worst of all, that Oswald had shot Tippitt before he latter could shoot him. On the other hand, he attributed the assassination to the "right." I'd like to open a dialogue with him.
