Dear Dr Shaw,

I am pleased to enclosed herewith the expanded name index of some thirty pages, as against the nine-page name index which I submitted earlier. You will see that I have added after each name a brief description of the individual, and a key to the categories of persons at the end of the index.

It has been called to my attention that the underlining of the name will be interpreted by a printer as a direction for italics. That was not my intention. As I said in an earlier letter, dated 7 October 1965, I believe, I am hopeful that it will be possible to model the subject index on the twenty-six Hearings and Exhibits volumes, in size appearance and style. Even if that is not possible, I should not like the underlined headings in the subject index or the underlined names to be type-set in italics. I hope that you will agree.

The only remaining task now is the citation-by-citation check of the subject index, to which I shall turn my attention now that the first two items mentioned in my letter of 19 November 1965 are out of the way. I hope that it will not be necessary to delay starting composition beyond your original target date of about the 10th of December.
