I am returning herewith the corrected proofs of my subject index to the Warren Report and Hearings & Exhibits, as requested in your letter of 4 January 1966. The word "court-martial" gave me some trouble, too, but according to Webster's Unabridged the correct plural is "courts-martial" (in case my marginal correction remains unclear).

Will I have an opportunity to check the final proofs or do you expect to go to press on the basis of the enclosed proofs? Can you indicate the approximate date of publication? Please drop me a note or, better still, telephone me at Chelsea 2-4293 (office number Plaza 4-1234 ext 2024) Area Code 212.

Several researchers who are working on the Warren Report and Hearings have been asking me when the index will be out, as they are impatient to obtain it. Does The Scarecrow Press offer its publications to the public as well as to libraries? Are announcements with order forms sent out? If so, I can supply the names and addresses of the interested researchers for your mailing list. I believe that the members and counsel of the Warren Commission, the Curator of the National Archives, and some of the witnesses in the case as well as writers and publications which have treated the assassination will also be interested. Perhaps I could discuss this with the person who handles advertising and/or sales?
