My Dear General Walker,

In reply to your letter of July 13, 1966, I wish to refer you to page 139 of the Subject Index and to invite your attention to the listing for your name, which is followed by the descriptive term "right-winger" in parentheses. You will note in the Warren Report on pages 292-299 a sub-section titled "Right-wing groups hostile to President Kennedy" in which your name is mentioned a number of times. You will find also on page 416 of the aforesaid Warren Report the statement that Oswald "had an extreme dislike of the rightwing, an attitude most clearly reflected by his attempt to shoot General Walker" --from which it appears evident that the Warren Commission in the first instance designated you as a right-winger.

I am not aware that the Warren Report utilizes the classification "Left-Wingers and Neo-Nazi" although the Report does designate various named groups or political parties with which the accused assassin corresponded or in which he demonstrated interest. You will find that information classified in the Subject Index on pages 17, 25, 29, 45, 58 and 59. ~~None of these groups or parties is mentioned in the Warren Report.~~

~~It is clearly a matter of historical record that the Warren Commission concluded that the assassin of the President acted alone, and that Ruby acted alone in his crime of murder. I am inclined to agree with you, however, that both crimes were organized plots involving trigger men and their fellow conspirators.~~

Finally, since you seem to object to being designated as a "right-winger," allow me to point out that, as stated in the preface to the Subject Index, the work is an attempt to classify the material in the Warren Report and the Hearings and Exhibits. It includes negative and collateral references as well as direct references and ~~in no case does the~~ ~~Index take any position~~ does not necessarily take a position with regard to the correctness or incorrectness of statements, exhibits, categorizations, or allegations in the Warren Report and the accompanying volumes of Hearings and Exhibits.
