

We are preparing for you copies of the following specific records of which you request copies in your letters:

- (1) Photograph of Mohammed Reggab
- (2) Two reports of interviews with Barbara Brooke. Neither the pictures taken by Barbara Brooke nor the photograph discussed in the interviews with Mrs. Wanda Schafer, Felix Parker, and Aaron Foster (CD 1066, pp. 440-443) are known to be among the records of the Commission. No additional information concerning these pictures is filed under the names involved.
- (3) Material relating to Harold Jerome Mandery, Billy Joe Lord, Lela Kathryn Lord, Donald Peter Camarata, and the Triangle Manufacturing Company
- (4) CD 1120; 1179; p. 100-104; and 1485, p. 4-6 and 11. There is no page 203 in CD 1484, as this document includes only 10 pages.
- (5) FBI interview with Jimmy Bosch dated November 23, 1963 (CD 1179, p. 40). We do not know of any material relating to Jimmy or Victor M. Bosch except the pages in CD 1179.
- (6) Mr. Shaffer's memorandum of February 7, 1964.
- (7) FBI memorandum of May 27, 1964, dealing with Herminio Portell-Vila and Mrs. Mariada Arensberg (CD 1040)
- (8) CD 1388 and CE 237

Pages 33 and 34 of CD 1481 are withheld from research.

We regret that our staff is not large enough to undertake the amount of work that would be necessary to provide information concerning the availability of material relating to the numerous names and subjects for which you request this information. We can do a limited amount of this kind of work, but not as much as would be required to furnish you the information requested in your letters. If you will select a few names and subjects concerning which you want information most urgently, we shall try to provide information concerning them. We would be pleased, of course, to make records of the Commission available to you in our research rooms in order that you can locate information yourself.
