Dear Sylvia,

Enclosed are a few more of the items I promised you a month ago. This is my file on Barbara Brookey (Barbara Brooke in the FBI reports). With all of the investigating I have done, this recent report shows how much I still have to learn. Next time I'll go directly to the phone company first. Not only is there the possibility that Barbara's photos show Oswald, there is also the outside shance that if it is not him, it could be a false Oswald. Everything I have on Barbara is included, and I will keep you up to date on what happens. Right now, as you will see when you read through the stuff, I am at the critical stage of waiting to see whether she will contact the FBI and ask for her slides back. Keep your fingers crossed. The irony is that her slides may prove to be of no value whatsoever, and all of this effort may be for naught. But one never knows until one thecks such things out.

It would be beneficial if the government ever decides to pay for a public and open investigation, which is not conducted by government agencies, if materials such as this have already been run down. This will reduce the number of things which still may be in existance but which the FBI or some other agency might destroy rather than having them get public exposure. Right now the government seems pretty smug that it will never have to re-open the case.

When I get a chance to take breaks in my studying in the coming months, I will try to mail other things which may be of interest to you. Last Sunday evening I got to use Fred Newcomb's slides which demonstrate that the photo of Oswald with the rifle is a composite on a CBS affiliate TV show out here. They went over quite well. For some reason I am suddenly getting pressure, including the FBI contacting a radio station after my appearance, a woman making many inquiries among those who have helped me but remained anenymous, the post office, and some characters who have set up a base of operations (that's their term) at a nearby motel. There is never any rhyme or reason to such things as far as I have been able to tell over the past several years.
