Thanks for the letter. Glad that you sent for Fred's slides, since they are well worthwhile. I agree about the fact that they help explain the length of the rifle vs. body height discrepancy which you point out in <u>Accessories</u> and make that comment often. By the way, they also go a long way in demonstrating differences in size of various body parts such as the fingers on the hand, buttons, collar, etc.

Thanks also for the info on William Worthy. To be very frank, he is very smooth and tends to tell little about himself, and that put me a bit on my guard. But what interests me the most is that he says he has a grant of \$1 million (\$250 thousand per year for 4 years) from the Black Univarian Universalist Conference to set up a committee to investigate Malcolm X's assassination. That's a hell of a lot of money for anything. In addition, he is not very enthusiastic about doing the work and wants to give it to Fenster-wald—something I advised against.

I will check for the microfilm on Minority of ONe. Is there anyway to contact M.S.Arnoni, who Vince tells me is either in or going to Israel? Those articles, which are historically important, would be very useful to me, not only for my own interest, but for the people who I am educating about this in my newly-formed Committee of Inquiry.

Enclosed are additions to the Martinsburg file and the Bolden file. (If you don't have the latter, tell me and I will send it.) In the case of Bolden, I sent him a Christmas card, and this is a photo of it when it was returned to me.
