On December 16, 1963, Secret Service Special Agent WILLIAM PATTERSON was contacted regarding the present whereabouts of ten Secret Service Agents who were escorting the President when President KENNEDY was assassinated on November 22, 1963. The list which had been furnished to the Dallas Office by the FBI Headquarters, Washington, D.C. contained the following names:

On December 16, 1963, Special Agent PATTERSON of the Secret Service, advised the above individuals comprised a group of agents who were traveling with the Presidential party on November 22, 1963, and none of these men were assigned to the Secret Service Office at Dallas, Texas. Agent PATTERSON stated these men departed from Dallas shortly after the assassination on November 22, 1963 and their whereabouts would have to be ascertained through the office of the Chief of Secret Service, Treasury Department, Washington, D.C.
