LINNIE MAE RANDEL, 439 West 5th Street, Irving, Texas, telephone BU 3-8965, advised that she is the sister of BUELL WESLEY PRAIER, who is employed by the Texas School Book Depository (TSBD) and resides at her residence. She said that she met LEE HARVEY OSWALD through her brother and has known OSWALD and his wife for approximately seven weeks.

On the morning of November 22, 1963, Mrs. RANDEL stated that she looked out of a window of her residence and observed OSWALD walking up her driveway, and to the best of her recollection OSWALD was wearing a tan shirt and grey jacket.

Mrs. RANDEL was shown a light green sport shirt with a hole in the right sleeve at the elbow, which, according to the arresting officers, was being worn by OSWALD at the time of his arrest on November 22, 1963. Mrs. RANDEL stated that the above-described shirt does not look familiar to her, that OSWALD could have been wearing this shirt, but she believes that the shirt OSWALD was wearing on the morning of November 22, 1963, was a solid color and light.
