Captain O. A. JONES, Forgery Bureau, Dallas Police Department, advised that he was the individual and not Captain J. W. FRANK who was investigating the assault to murder offense wherein WARREN A. REYNOLDS was the victim. Captain JONES furnished a copy of offense report No. 3495071, which reflects that on January 28, 1964, at approximately 9:15 PM, WARREN A. REYNOLDS, while in the basement of the JONKEY REYNOLDS Motor Company, 580 East Jefferson, had been shot in the head by someone using a .22 caliber rifle. Captain JONES stated that the prime suspect in this offense was DARRYL HARVEY GARNER, white male, age 24, also known as "DICK", and that the apparent motive was a falling out between GARNER and REYNOLDS involving the efforts of GARNER to sell REYNOLDS a used automobile.

Captain JONES stated that nothing had been developed in the investigation to connect this matter in anyway with the LEE HARVEY OSWALD investigation. Captain JONES stated that should any information be developed in the future connecting same with the OSWALD case that he would immediately advise the FBI.
