On February 13, 1964 the Dallas Times Herald newspaper carried a UPI release "WALKER claims Communist Cell Active in Dallas" which release was datelined Shreveport, Louisiana.

This article stated that a radio interview was had with former General EDWIN A. WALKER by radio station KWKH on the evening of February 12, 1964. It stated that WALKER had remarked that there was a Communist cell in Dallas which government investigators knew about and that "it is perfectly clear" that LEE HARVEY OSWALD "was working with the Communist cell in Dallas."

This article stated that General WALKER had said he did not know if OSWALD was questioned or arrested in connection with an attempted shooting of WALKER.

According to the article, General WALKER stated in his radio interview that he had never been questioned by a federal officer in connection with the attempt on his life, and no other law enforcement agent had contacted him since he called them and had them remove a bullet from his home.

It should be noted that previous investigation has reflected that LEE HARVEY OSWALD allegedly shot at General WALKER at his home on April 10, 1963.
