You will understand this when details change as rapidly as they have in this case - perhaps "reported" details would be better.

I belong to no organizations other than the Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod and the Republican Party - have been precinct chairman for several two year terms and delegate to county & state conventions. By profession I am a sociologist. Have lived in Dallas only a month and am here to work on doctorate at SMU beginning in January. Am 47 years old and employment background is in oil business. My interest in the case is great both for professional and personal reasons.

Yesterday morning early I clocked (by car) Oswald's reported movements from the corner of Beckley & Neely to rooming house, to site of Tippit shooting, to the Texas theater.

I attended the various services at Dealey Plaza on Nov. 22 - top crowd at any time during morning was about 200. The people here have a somewhat restrained approach to the whole situation. While there, took a look at "board fence" - it hides a rather unsightly unofficial parking area along ry. tracks - you really should make an effort to view the site and surroundings if you have not. I've been told that the natural contours of the earth and the surrounding buildings form an echo chambers which is almost perfect. This probably accounts for the confusion about the origin of the shots.

My time is limited but I'll help you if I can. Just let me have a list of what you need in order of priority and I'll do my best. A friend remarked that she had kept the papers (Dels) - did you mean at the time, i.e. - Nov. 22, 1963 and immediately thereafter?
