Dear Sylvia -

My reaction was pretty much the same as yours. I don't think the situation is basically changed, however. Ruby's loyalty (and silence) seem to be ideological in concept - the toughest kind to crack. My one persistent thought has been, therefore, that the most well-known rabbi (necessary to appeal to Ruby's ego) might have some influence on his final days.

If he was implanted with cancer, "they" must have been very certain that he was 100% safe - silent - for their ~~pur~~ purposes.
