Dear Sylvia:

I have accepted a job with the State in the Child Welfare Unit with headquarters in Kerrville, Texas. If not, please advise and I may be able to get some of my friends to help you if you so desire or require.

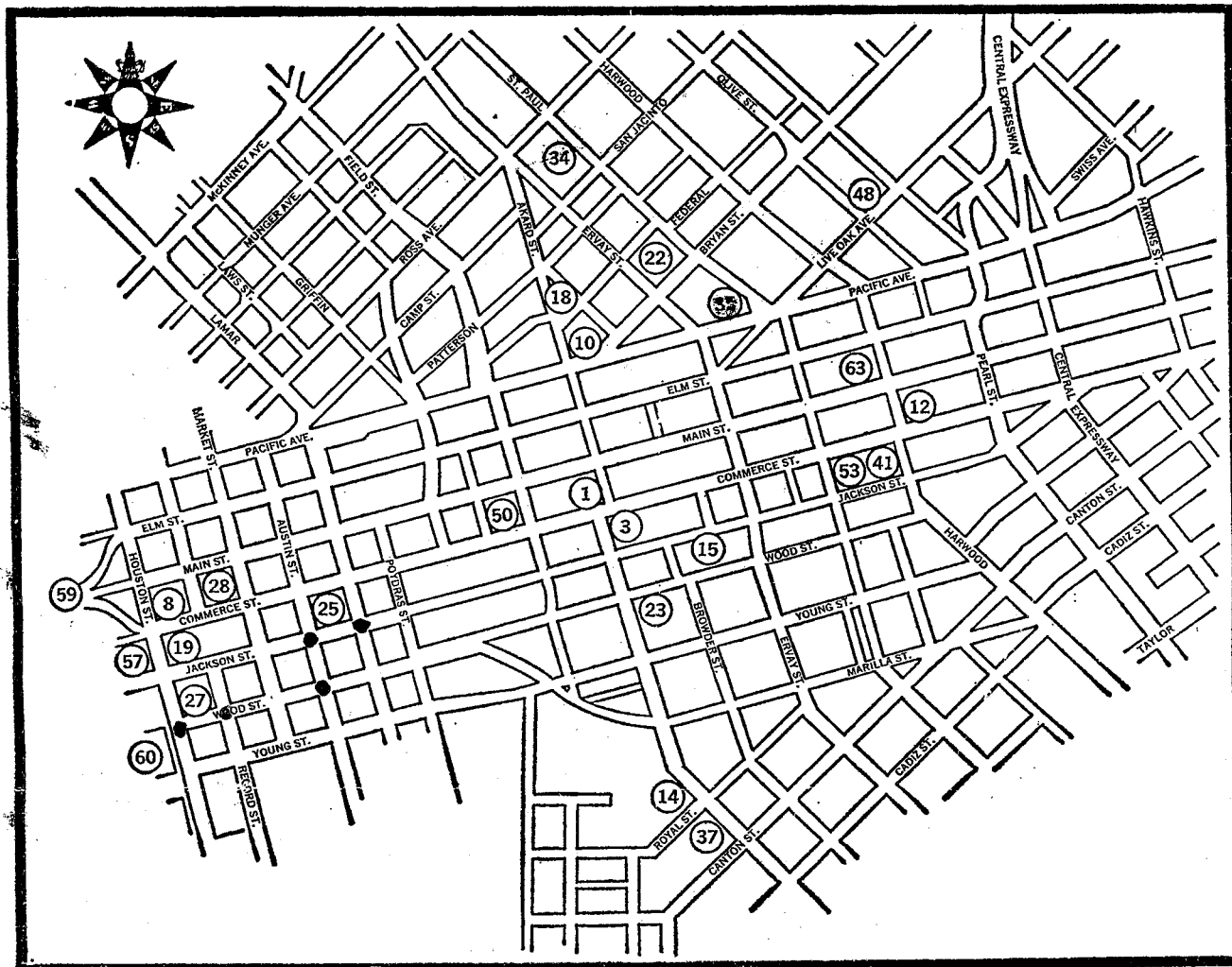

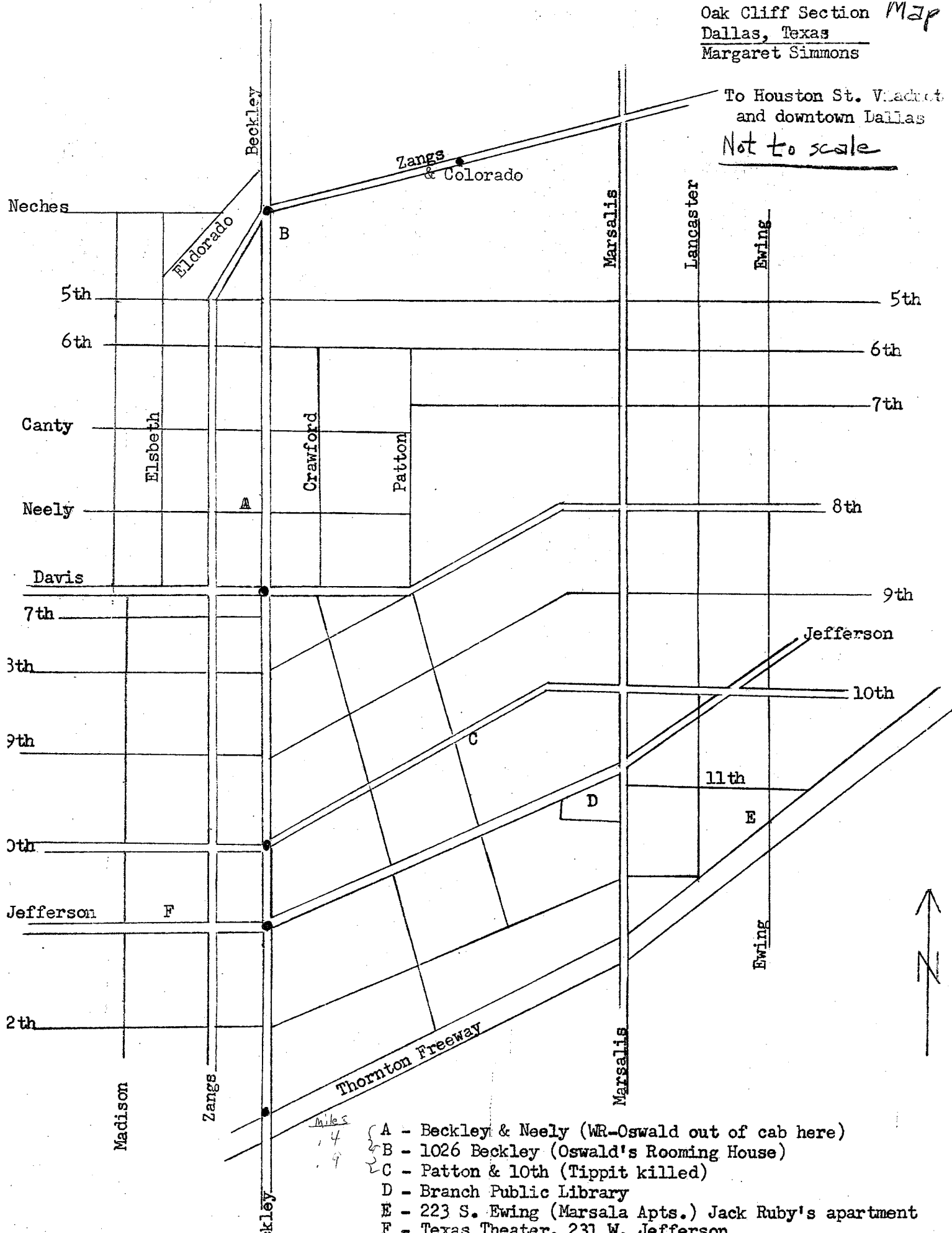
# INSET MAP OF DOWNTOWN DALLAS
