Dear Miss Bestdorff,

Re my phone call this afternoon about Sylvia Meagher's SUBJECT INDEX to the WARREN REPORT and HEARINGS & EXHIBITS: Am enclosing a short strip of the film on which I have placed a carefully cut scrap of paper showing the size & orientation of each frame on the film. The dotted line represents the fold of the book, two pages being shown per frame. Enclosed also is a Thermofax of one of the pages as provided in printed form by the NY library.

My interest in knowing your copying capability is that I'd prefer to give the film to a library which ^{is} able to make the best use of it, including the ability to provide copies for those requesting it. If your machine can produce a double-page copy, as shown in the enclosed copy, then you should be able to supply a copy of the book on request for \$7.80, if I counted the sheets right. And this would certainly be an appreciated service for those needing this out-of-print Index. (There are, incidentally, 3 sheets of errata not on the film.)

In the event that the film can be viewed but not copied, as you suggest might be the case, then I would give it to another library. In that case, however, I would supply you with a Thermofax copy of my NY library copy for your use.

Let me take my hat off to y'all for having a set of the 27 at the library!
