Notes on Photos from Book

- page 2 Photo looking south on Houston. Crowd along east side of Houston roped off. Dallas Morning News - Beers - About 3 PM
- page 3 Photo of TSBD from sidewalk corner Main & Houston. Lot of people. TSBD doorway doesn't show. Dallas Morning News - Beers - Time on clock looks like 2:25
- page 4 Photo from Dal Tex Building. Caption says from TSBD. Also photo on mark on curb with police hand pointing with pencil (Dillard). Dallas Morning News - Beers
- page 5 Photo of sixth floor corner. Boxes hide corner. Also photo of spot where rifle found. Day points to spot. Dallas Morning News - Beers
- page 6 Photo of Day with rifle. Movie cameraman in Murray (Decker) picture who looks like Seymour. Peter Lawford is in background. Dallas Morning News - Beers
