Through the good offices of a friend who was Executive Director of Inter. Rescue Committee and is now a member of its board, I was given an opportunity to look through the FBI file on Oswald, Lee Harvey. I did so this morning and was allowed to xerox whatever I wanted. Accompanying this letter are copies I made for you.

In the whole, there's nothing much. It was a slim file. I noted six documents and a couple of notes. One of the latter was suggestive of interesting possibilities because it was from

The President of I.B.C. on the stationery of the Department of Justice of which, I believe, he was an employee or officer at the time of the assassination of Kennedy and its immediate aftermath.

Notice in Steenberg's letter to Rankin he says "we received a letter from Mr. Harwell of the Wilberger County Chapter, Vernon, Texas - - - - ." In the next sentence he says, "Mr. Harwell's not in our file." The letter ^{to Rankin} was written on May 1, 1964. ~~It~~

The letter was not in the I.B.C. file on May 1, 1964, how did Steenberg know it was from "Wilberger County Chapter, Vernon, Texas."

If you do not know I intend to ask Steenberg.
