Dear Sylvia,

Thanks for the copy of Wecht's letter. It is very confusing. First, the question of the rifle stock. I believe he said "split," for immediate tel, called May's attention to it and made a note of it. To be sure I may have misheard. But that is not as important as Wecht's failure to indicate what was wrong with the stock and to cite the source of his information. We know to what should clues can lead us. Inasmuch as he "cannot get involved in meaningful correspondence" with me on the subject, I pray you will undertake to clarify the matter with him.

Even more important is his failure to say whether he believes ^{of Dallas Tippett} Oswald guilty as he very distinctly implied in his radio colloquy. If you put it to him, his failure to respond is disturbing.

If he believes Oswald guilty, it is in contradiction of his complete
"agreement" with the theory of the assassination "gisted" in
my letter to Vincent which he thinks you wrote. It is all very
confusing. Will you under take to unravel the mystery?

I suppose the correspondence with Vincent has run its course.
I think I hit him too hard and he is suffering - We'll see.
