The material is confirmatory of old criticism, revelatory of suspected misfeasance and malfeasance, and a touchstone for exposure of current villainy; e.g. it is clear that Hasty's dirty work is the source of the current garbage (Ladre's Home Journal) about the Oswald's per life. With respect to your own focus of concern, it documents the Johnson policy to denude the assassination of political significance and motivation, which predetermined the W.C.'s findings, and is the key to its manipulation and suppression of evidence; and, therefore, completes the shift of target from the W.C. to the frame up, from which the committee, it confesses, in effect, ran away.
