Dear Mr. Yslas:

In 1975, the Board of Police Commissioners committed itself to provide information in response to written inquiries about the facts of the Robert F. Kennedy assassination. I have been deeply involved in questions concerning the assassination for some time, and am writing to request the following information:

- 1.) The police records of the measurements of the Ambassador Hotel pantry and the adjacent area at the time of the shooting and the dimensions and locations of the steam tables, ice machines and other relevant physical features of this area.
- 2.) The return on the search warrant of Sirhan Sirhan's car.
- 3.) Any written reports by officers William Lee, Robert Rozzi, Charles Wright or other officers on duty at the time, concerning the physical evidence in or around the crime scene after the shooting.
- 4.) The captions or other explanatory information in connection with the photographs of the crime scene taken by police on the morning of the assassination and during the crime reconstructions and released as part of the 1975 court proceedings.
- 5.) A list by source and content of the photographic and film material taken into custody by police covering the period before the shooting and the first day afterwards.
- 6.) A list by source and content of audio recordings in police custody covering the period from an hour before the shooting to an hour afterwards.
- 7.) The index and table of contents to the ten-volume summary report of Special Unit Senator.

8.) The property reports for police booked evidence items, numbers:
1-10, 24-25, 28, 55, 58-82, 102-104, 106-112, 116-155.

If necessary, I am willing to cover photocopy costs entailed by this material. Also, if certain items can be furnished more quickly or readily than others, I would appreciate it if these could be sent separately, without awaiting the complete group.

Thank you for your assistance in making this important information available.
